

How to get from Leiden central station to the Huygens Laboratory

On foot:

It takes about 20–25 minutes to walk from Leiden central station to the Huygens Laboratory. One possible route which keeps you away from heavy traffic is as follows (see also the map on the next page): Exit the station at the side where track 9 is and walk along Albinusdreef past the LUMC. Turn left into Sandifortdreef and continue along Zernikedreef and Einsteinweg. Finally, take a right into Niels Bohrweg and you are there.

By taxi:

Take the main exit towards Leiden city (at the side where track 1 is); the taxis are located left of this exit. The fare to the Huygens Laboratory should be about 15 € and the ride typically takes 5 minutes. (There is a bank at that side of the station, too, where you can change money or use EC/Maestro/creditcards to get cash at the ATMs.)

By bus:

Take the main exit towards Leiden city (at the side where track 1 is); the buses depart from the bay to the right of this exit. You can either take bus 43 (cf. the dotted line on the map) to Den Haag CS, in which case you have to get out at “Universiteitsterrein,” or bus 57 (see dashed line), direction Lisse/Hoofddorp, to the stop “Corpus.” The ride takes about 10 minutes with either line, depending a bit on traffic. Tickets can be bought from the driver for about 2 €.

The bus schedule on weekdays is as follows (updated 2013-11-28):

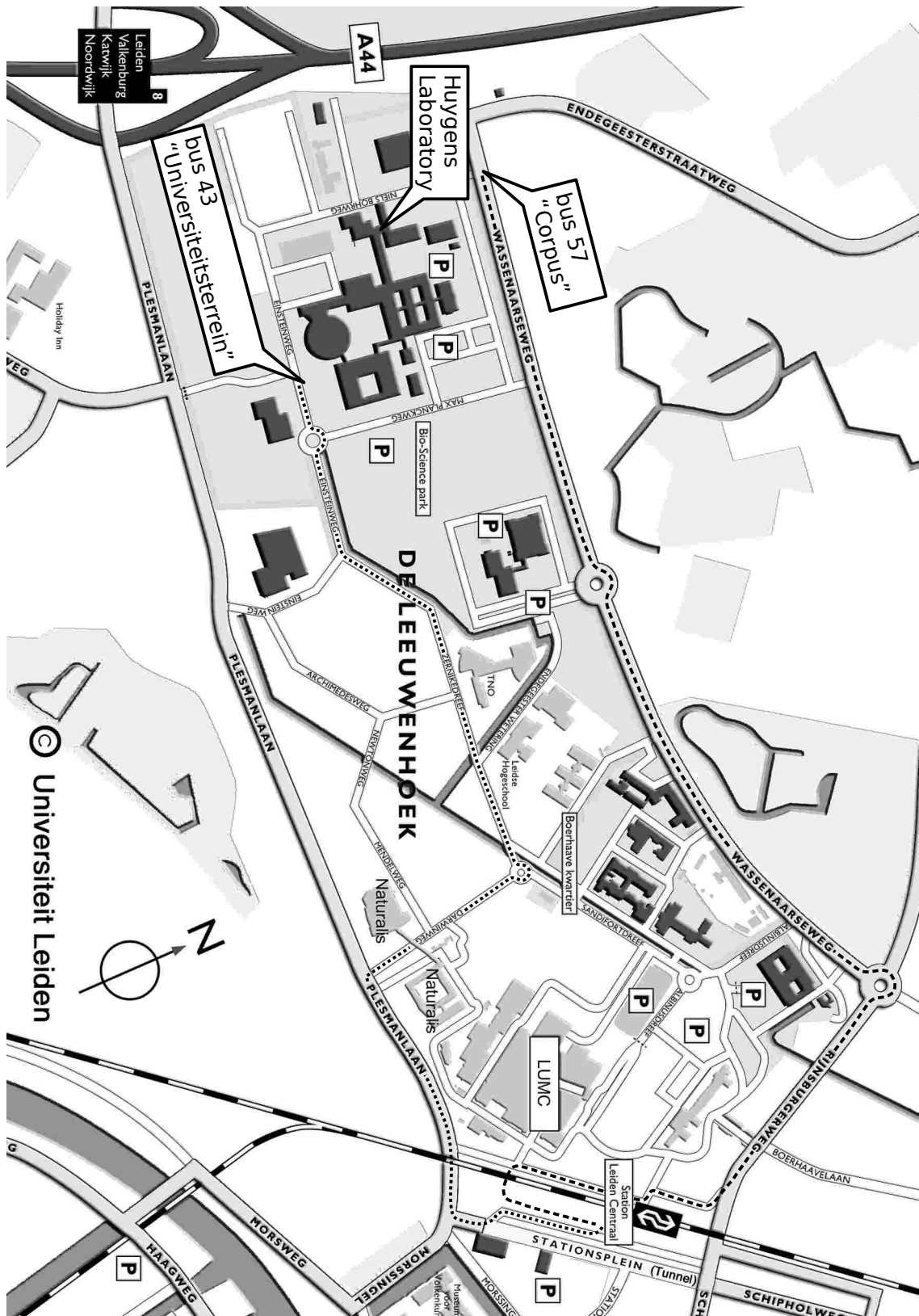

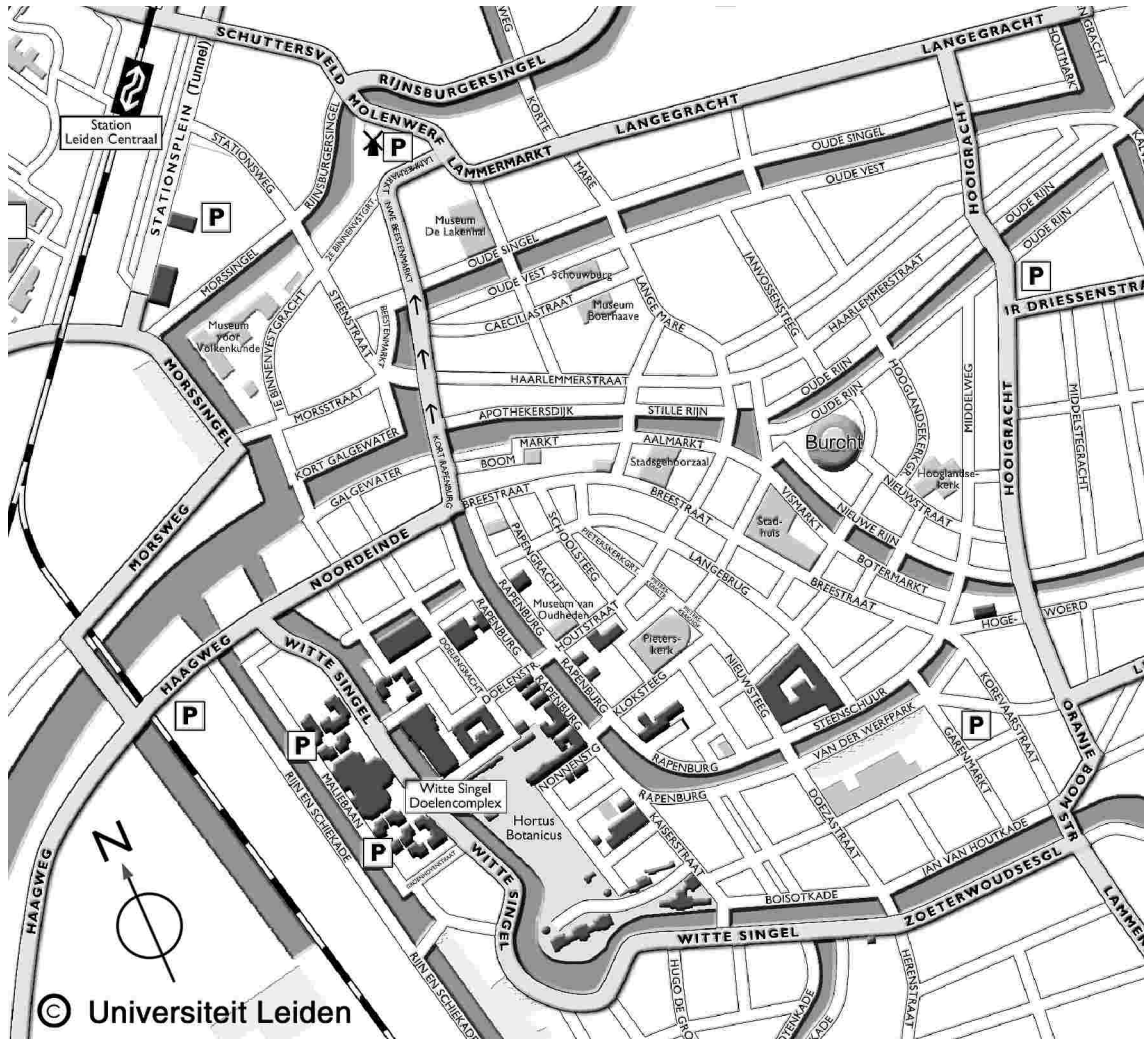
In the building:
